PRO-PA-GAN-DA: Information given out which is biased

SPHERE: the shape of a globe, the sky

STOCK-HOLD-ER: person who owns part of a company

RE-CRUIT-MENT: to enroll in the military

MI-LI-TIA: a military force smaller than an army

MASS-A-CRE: the killing of many people at once

OC-CU-PA-TION: conquest or control of a nation; also a job

HOL-O-CAUST: widespread destruction; genocide of Jews and others by the Nazi's

A-TROC-I-TY: monstrous behavior or event; a terrible thing

LI-BER-AL: open to new opinions, willing to change if things will get better

LEFT-WING: the liberal side of politics, progressive, people who want more freedom.

RIGHT-WING: conservative side in politics, things stay the same, people who want to save money

CON-SER-VA-TIVE: traditions are more important than change, cautious of new things

RE-GIME: the government in power

AU-THOR-I-TAR-I-AN: strict obedience to the law rather than allowing freedom

MER-CE-NAR-Y: a soldier who is fights only for money

GUER-RIL-LA: a soldier with a small group of soldiers defending their nation from a more powerful enemy

CIA: the American secret police, stands for Central Intelligence Agency

A-PART-HEID: a racist government where many are ruled by a few of a different race (from South Africa where millions of blacks were ruled by a thousands of whites)

IN-TER-VE-NE: to come between so as to change what happens, like breaking up a fight

MIL-I-TA-RISM: a government that believes in a strong military and that is aggressive
